Down Payment, Payment of Purchase Price, Fees

1. Buyer will pay a down payment of \$500.00 CAD with payment of the balance of \$_____CAD due prior to release of the Dog to Buyer. Payment of the deposit may be made by cash or by electronic/digital payment. Payment of the remaining balance is to be made by cash no later than 8 weeks of birth.

Buyer acknowledges and agrees that Buyer will forfeit the deposit and any rights to the Dog if:

- (a) Buyer fails to complete the purchase of the Dog for any reason, or
- (b) Buyer fails to pay the balance of the Purchase Price within 8 weeks of birth.
- (c) Buyer fails to meet the Breeder's ethical requirements prior to the Dog being released.

In either event, Breeder shall be free to sell the Dog to another party.

In the event the Dog is not available due to sickness, death, or any other circumstance owing to the fault of the Breeder, Buyer's down payment will be transferred to the next litter of puppies or returned to the Buyer in full.

General Health Guarantee Terms

- 2. North Legacy Labradors guarantees this Dog to be in good health and to the best of our knowledge free from any congenital defects at the time of purchase.
- 3. North Legacy Labradors guarantees this Dog to have had a full physical examination, vaccinated at 7 weeks of age against Distemper, Adenovirus, and Parvovirus, dewormed at 2, 4, and 6 weeks of age with Pyrantel Pamoate, and microchipped and registered to the Buyers information.
- 4. If the Buyer feels this Dog is not healthy, the Buyer may return the Dog to the Breeder for a full refund within 72 hours of purchase if written proof is provided with a description of the Dogs illness by a licensed veterinarian including the clinics letterhead and contact information.

Return-to-Breeder Agreement

5. If at any time the Buyer is unable to keep or care for the Dog, it will be returned to the Breeder. The Dog may not be transferred or sold by the Buyer. The Buyer's understanding and acceptance of this condition is signified here by his or her initials: ______ on ______ (date). The Breeder will endeavor to place any returned Dog as advantageously as possible. If a purchase price is obtained for the Dog, it will be refunded to the original Buyer, less any costs of placement. If the Dog is placed free of charge, no money will be returned to the original buyer. No veterinary or other costs of keeping the Dog, or any other costs incurred by the Buyer resulting from his/her ownership of the Dog, will be paid by the Breeder to the original buyer of the Dog under any circumstances.

Animal Health and Welfare

- 6. The Buyer agrees to maintain the Dog's health with yearly vaccinations as specified by their veterinarian and the Province of Ontario.
- 7. The Buyer agrees to socialize, train, and keep the Dog in a manner acceptable to the Breeder.
- 8. If at any time, the Breeder finds that the Dog is being kept or treated in a manner not acceptable to her, the Buyer agrees to surrender the Dog to the Breeder with ownership transfer adequately signed.
- 9. Should the Dog become ill or unsound, all costs of treatment will be the responsibility of the Buyer.

Non-Breeding Agreement, Spay, Neuter

- 10. The Buyer agrees that the Dog will not be bred and will spay/neuter the Dog no later than 30 months of age unless otherwise recommended by the Buyer's veterinarian.
- 11. The Breeder reserves the right to request proof of spay/neuter or proof of the veterinarian's recommendation with the veterinarian's letterhead and contact information included.

- 12. The Buyer agrees that the Dog is being sold under a Non-Breeding Agreement as a family companion, not for breeding purposes. This Dog is not to be bred under any Kennel Club rules or those rules of any other registry. Rescinding the Non-breeding Agreement requires the consent of both the Breeder and the Buyer. If this Dog is bred and/or produces a litter the Buyer is responsible to the Breeder for breach of this contract and agrees to pay damages to the Breeder in the amount of \$5,000.00 CAD. If a litter is produced the Buyer agrees to pay the Breeder an additional \$2000.00 CAD per puppy. The Buyer agrees that if the ownership of this Dog is transferred that the non-breeding contract remains in effect.
- 13. If the Breeder sees i.e., social media, newspaper, website, marketplace, or any other selling platforms and/or hears that the Buyer is breeding and/or selling litter(s) of any monetary amount, the Breeder will file a lawsuit against the Buyer for financial damages.

Health Guarantee

- 14. A warranty for **Hip and Elbow Dysplasia** is provided for **two (2) years** from the birthdate of this Dog. If this Dog is diagnosed with hip or elbow dysplasia, Buyer must provide OFA or Penn HIP certified x-rays proving a Hip and/or Elbow Dysplasia diagnosis. All hip and elbow testing to be done at Buyers expense.
- 15. A **lifetime warranty** is provided for the following **genetic diseases**: exercise induced collapse (EIC), progressive retinal atrophy (PRA and PRA2), pyruvate kinase deficiency, macular corneal dystrophy, day blindness, canine elliptocytosis, Alexander disease, narcolepsy, centronuclear myopathy, x-lined myotubular myopathy, congenital myasthenic syndrome, hereditary nasal parakeratosis, and skeletal dysplasia.
- 16. Documents and diagnoses pertaining to the above-mentioned genetic diseases must be made and provided to the Breeder from a licensed veterinarian and one of the following genetic screening companies: Embark, Optimal Selection, or Wisdom Panel. All genetic testing to be done at the Buyers expense.
- 17. A lifetime warranty is provided for inherited genetic heart and eye diseases.
- 18. Documents and diagnoses pertaining to the heart and eyes must be made and provided to the Breeder from a veterinary specialist. Genetic Eye Diseases must be documented and diagnosed by a licensed Veterinary **Ophthalmologist**. Genetic Heart Diseases must be documented and diagnosed by a licensed Veterinary **Cardiologist**. All heart and eye testing to be done at the Buyers expense.
- 19. The above hip, elbow, and heart health guarantees are void if:
 - a. The Buyer fails to feed a large breed puppy kibble (grain inclusive and AAFCO approved) for the first year of the Dog's life.
 - b. The Buyer feeds the Dog raw, home-cooked, boutique, grain-free or any other non-AAFCO approved diet during any stage of the Dog's life.
- 20. If any of the above Health Guarantees are not fulfilled by the Breeder and appropriate veterinary proof has been provided, the Breeder will either provide the Buyer with a replacement Dog from the next available litter at no cost, or the Buyer will be refunded half the purchase price of the original Dog.
